ISOI students and staff have a long standing relationship. The Hospice is a group to which our students feel an ongoing connection and commitment. External conditions sometimes dictate the frequency and type of contact our students and St. Joseph's resident enjoy, however, the bond has been an enduring one.

Different students groups at the International School of Islamabad regularly help and visit the St. Joseph's Hospice in Rawalpindi, a hospice of about 75 terminally ill patients and orphans. ACT, the National Honor Society, and the Elementary Leadership Council are just some of the groups who have made visits on Saturdays to the Hospice to spend time with the patients. The School's Choir and Band have also performed at the Hospice during different school years. In addition, students regularly have newspaper or material drives to send items to the Hospice. It is a friendly environment and safe environment in which ISOI's students can have a meaningful connection with other children and people who are less fortunate than themselves.
