

Required Qualifications for Teachers and Administrators

- Bachelor's Degree / Master's Degree from an accredited university or college.
- A valid and current teaching or administrator certificate, license or credential.
- References reflecting successful teaching or administrative experience.
- A minimum of two-three years prior teaching or administrative experience.
- A willingness to serve as an advisor or sponsor student co-curricular activities.
- A willingness to serve on program improvement and Strategic Planning committees.
- A willingness to model professional behavior, high personal expectations, total commitment to the assignment and a quest for performance excellence.
- The ability to adjust to a foreign location and the demands of a fast-paced school.

Preferred Qualifications (in addition to the above)

- A Master's Degree or professional preparation beyond the Bachelor's Degree in the field of Education / Administration.
- Five or more years of previous teaching or administrative experience with at least two of those years in an overseas, American-based curriculum school.
- North American professional certification.
- A willingness to continue employment beyond the initial two-year contract.
